Macon-Bibb County Code of Ordinances Sec. 22-22.

(b) Disability: Any developed residential premises owned in whole by an individual who has been found, adjudicated, or declared totally (100 percent) disabled and unable to work by either the U.S. Social Security Administration or U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs may be exempted from payment of the fee for providing solid waste collection and disposal services, provided the developed residential premises is the individual's primary residence. In order to qualify for the exemption, the individual must submit an application in accordance with Subsection (c)(2) of this Section, including individuals who have previously applied for and received this exemption.

(c) Applications for exemption:

(2) Applications for exemption for disabled persons: Applications for exemptions under paragraph (b) of this Section may be obtained from the Macon-Bibb County Solid Waste Department, or any successor department. The solid waste director or their designee must receive all applications and required documentation for exemptions for the succeeding calendar year by November 1st at 5:00 P.M. No late applications will be accepted. No renewal is required for this exemption and the exemption shall continue until such time as it shall expire automatically upon the first occurrence of: title to the property being conveyed to a subsequent owner of the real property tax parcel upon which the developed residential premises is located; or the exempted property ceases to be the exempted individual's primary residence; or the exempted individual's death.

(d) Approval or denial of application for exemption: The solid waste director, in his/her sole discretion, shall approve or deny the application for exemption. All decisions will be made within fifteen (15) business days of submission of the application.
